How Does **My Visco™** Program Work?

DePuy Synthes Mitek Sports Medicine My Visco™ Program is limited to cash-paying patients with a valid prescription for ORTHOVISC® or MONOVISC® who are either: (1) uninsured; or (2) enrolled in a commercial health insurance plan that does not cover ORTHOVISC, MONOVISC or any other intra-articular hyaluronic acid injection products for any or all indications of such products. The My Visco Program is not available to patients enrolled in Medicare, Medicaid, Tricare, VA or any other government health care program.

ORTHOVISC and MONOVISC are synovial joint fluid replacement therapies for pain associated with osteoarthritis of the knee.

- These injections may provide up to 6 months of pain relief with just 1, 3, or 4 injections.¹
- ORTHOVISC and MONOVISC are safe and FDA-approved, non-drug therapies.

WHAT DO I DO IF MY INSURANCE DOESN'T COVER HAS (VISCOSUPPLEMENTATION)?

- You may be eligible for the **My Visco** Program through DePuy Synthes Mitek Sports Medicine, which is a discounted program for MONOVISC or ORTHOVISC. Talk to your doctor to determine which product is right for you.

HOW WILL I PAY FOR MY INJECTIONS?

- Patient's payment for ORTHOVISC or MONOVISC will be coordinated by CareMed. If you decide to participate in the **My Visco** Program, CareMed will walk you through the payment process.

HOW WILL IT BE SHIPPED?

- The injections will be shipped to your doctor's office by CareMed and you will need an appointment to receive the injection(s).

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE?

- Your injections should ship to your doctor's office within 1 week of confirmed payment.

Important Safety Information

High Molecular Weight Hyaluronan is indicated in the treatment of pain in osteoarthritis (OA) of the knee in patients who have failed to respond adequately to conservative nonpharmacologic therapy and to simple analgesics, e.g., acetaminophen. In clinical studies, the most commonly reported adverse events for ORTHOVISC were arthralgia, back pain, and headache. Other side effects included local injection site adverse events. In clinical studies, the most commonly reported adverse events for MONOVISC were arthralgia, joint swelling and injection site pain. ORTHOVISC and MONOVISC are contraindicated in patients with known hypersensitivity to hyaluronate formulations or known hypersensitivity (allergy) to gram positive bacterial proteins. ORTHOVISC and MONOVISC should not be injected in patients with infections or skin diseases in the area of the injection site or joint. MONOVISC should not be administered to patients with known bleeding disorders.

Patients are prohibited from submitting any claims for reimbursement for products purchased through the My Visco Program to any federal or state health care program (including without limitation Medicare, Medicaid, TRICARE, and the Veterans Health Administration), to any commercial prescription drug insurance program, or to any other payer.
